Schools Health Procedure Here Is Outlined

Procedure for handling various health problems which confront the schools, was called to the attention of the Board of Education recently by Mrs. Vivian Markham, school nurse.

She reported: "When a doctor or a nurse discovers a beginning difficulty and sees that treatment is started early enough to be easy and effective, a feeling exists that the work is worthwhile. The teachers at Walteria recently have done an outstanding piece of work in referring students who might have been seriously handicapped later on if neglected. By conferring with the parent and examining the students, many were directed toward invaluable help. The work piled up, but the parents were more thoughtful and patient than any such group has ever been."

"Between twenty-five and fifty students have been selected as possibly having hearing deficiency. As soon as we know

for sure they will be referred to specialists for treatment.

"There are seventeen dentists and one resident dentist who are offering their services for free dental care at the Harbor General hospital. They include: Dr. R. G. Bailey, Dr. Arthur Berke, Dr. R. Bingham, Dr. R. F. Bishop, Dr. O. E. Fossum, Dr. R. A. Hoag, Dr. W. A. Hoxie.

"If residents are not able to pay for dental care they may apply for free or part-pay care at the Harbor General hospital admitting office on Carson st., east of Normandie. The hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Only families with limited income are eligible for service.

"A new schedule by which the school nurse is able to visit each school one half day a week, has been announced.


"An appeal was made to the Catholic Welfare worker at the Pueblo to help in the campaign for clean personal habits and clean heads. It is apparently a

problem of slow education which cannot be solved in a matter of months. There are more social and racial factors in the problem than are immediately apparent.

"The doctor and the nurse attended the preview in Los Angeles of the film "Human Growth," shown to educators and school health personnel.

"After sending a questionnaire to each teacher asking for a list of students who are suspected of needing help because of some physical handicap, it is apparent that visual and auditory handicaps lead by a very wide margin. The audiometer is already proving to be a valuable adjunct in meeting this situation. Out of seven students tested, three were found to need careful watching as they are borderline cases with some hearing loss, and one student has a greater loss, necessitating his being referred to the hearing clinic."
