Two Arlington Avenue Name Changes Sought

The name of Narbonne avenue may be applied to most of Torrance's Arlington avenue under a recommendation passed Tuesday by the street naming committee of the County Planning Congress.

Recommendation that the change be made will be sent to the Torrance city council by the street naming group, which simultaneously dropped a proposal to change the names of both Narbonne and Arlington to Van Ness avenue.

Narbonne will extend as far north as Del Amo (203rd) street in Torrance under the recommendation passed Tuesday by the street naming committee, Secretary J. F. Armstrong said.

The street naming group also will suggest, Armstrong said, that the Torrance City Council change the name of Arlington from 190th street to Redondo Beach boulevard to read "Van Ness."

As Arlington now stops at Del Amo (203rd st.) then starts again north at 190th street, opposition against the second proposal may develop in Torrance on the grounds that if the street were joined in the future it would be called by two names within the Torrance city limits.

The streets in question start northward in Lomita as Narbonne, change to Arlington at Sepulveda avenue in Torrance. Arlington stops at Del Amo (203rd st.) then starts again at 190th street and runs to Redondo Beach boulevard where Torrance ends.

Armstrong said that latest proposal was made for the purpose of simplifying the names of the streets, making Narbonne a continuous thoroughfare to Del Amo and Van Ness continuous from 190th street north into Los Angeles.

The original proposal to change the names of all the streets, including Narbonne, to Van Ness met with serious opposition among Lomita groups.

The Lomita Business Association went on record against the proposal and mustered all the opposition it could get together on very short notice for Tuesday's street committee session.

H. P. Osborne Sr. represented the L.B.A. at the confab and presented letters of protest from representatives of many Lomita organizations.


"Though some weeks have passed since the 1947 Christmas Seal Sale, it is not too late to make payment for Christmas Seals used and not yet purchased."
