## 120 New Homes To Start On Kettler Tract

Construction will start next week on 120 more homes in Kettler Knolls tract, John Kettler told the Torrance Herald yesterday.

The new unit, to be located between Walnut street and Western avenue, Sepulveda boulevard and 235th street, will increase the total number of new homes in Kettler Knolls to 320. Kettler said that all of the original groups of homes, 109 in the first and 94 in the second, have been sold, and 25 of the new tract already are sold.

"They are going faster than we can build them," Kettler said. The homes will add some \$600,000 to the building total of Torrance this year.

## Frenger Must File New Plea For Variance

Due to the protests of adjoining property owners, E. S. Frenger must file a new petition for zoning variance to permit construction of a trailer court on Hawthorne boulevard and Emerald street. The variance was granted on July 1, 1947, and work started. Later A. J. Trahan, 3707 Emerald street, and Luther Mumford, 2325 Torrance boulevard, filed protests and convinced the City Council to order new proceedings. The property is the south 165 feet of lot 17, tract 3458.

Meanwhile, Mumford has filed a petition for change of zone for all of lot 17, from agricultural to limited commercial use. He owns the north 140 feet of the lot. His petition has been referred to the City Planning Commission which granted the original Frenger zoning variance petition.
