New Financial Responsibility Law Explained

Q. What is the California Financial Responsibility Law?

A. It is an act designed to protect the citizens of California against proven financially irresponsible drivers. In simplest terms, it declares that a motor vehicle operator who kills or injures another person or damages property in excess of \$100 must stand prepared to make a financial settlement with the victim or forfeit his driving privilege.

Q. When does the California Financial Responsibility Law become operative?

A. July 1, 1948.

Q. Who administers the law?

A. The Department of Motor Vehicles.

Q. How does the Financial Responsibility Law operate?

A. It requires every driver involved in an accident causing injury, death, or damage in excess of \$100 to the property of any one person to make a report on a special form to the Department of Motor Vehicles, Financial Responsibility, Sacramento, within 10 days. Within 60 additional days the driver must deposit sufficient cash or security to meet any damage judgment arising from the mishap. Automobile liability insurance meets the security provisions. Your driver's license will be suspended automatically if you fail to meet either of these provisions.

Q. What is the procedure if I carry automobile liability insurance?

A. You must make a complete accident report. You will fill out the insurance slip at the bottom of the report form. The Department will send the insurance slip to your insurance company whose responsibility it will be to advise if you are not covered. If you are, you have met the requirements of the law.

Q. Who determines the amount of security to be deposited with the Department of Motor Vehicles?

A. Evaluators of the Department set the amount after study of all reports on the accident.

Q. Where can I obtain accident report forms?

A. From any office of the Department of Motor Vehicles, California Highway Patrol, Police Department, Auto Club or your insurance agent or broker.

Q. Am I liable under the law if the accident wasn't my fault?

A. Yes. It makes no difference whether you were to blame or not.

Q. What is the procedure if I am so badly injured that I can't report the accident?

A. Have someone prepare the report for you. If you were not the owner of the car, it is the owner's responsibility to see that the report is made.

Q. Am I subject to the law if I am a non-resident?

A. Yes. Everyone, with a few exceptions, who operates a motor vehicle in California must observe the Financial Responsibility Law. If you are a non-resident and you fail to comply with it, your driving privilege in California will be suspended.



NEW FORD LINE GOES ON DISPLAY



The distinctive styling of the 1949 Ford convertible features smooth, flowing contours, full fender-width body and luxurious interior appointments. Completely new, the convertible chassis is doubly reinforced. It is one of the half dozen models to be on display starting tomorrow at Schultz & Peckham, 1420 Cabrillo ave., Ford dealers in Torrance since 1921.

New Textured Fabrics Used for Interiors

A precedent has been established in the low-priced automotive field by combining hand-someness and beauty with durability and comfort in the interiors of the 1949 Ford cars, which will be on display starting Friday of this week at Schultz & Peckham, 1420 Cabrillo avenue, Torrance. The local Ford showrooms will remain open both Friday and Saturday evenings this week, it was announced.

Ford has broken away from the neutral tones which have been traditional for mass production automobiles as designers have turned to textured fabrics popular in fashions and interior decorating. Of the three new fabrics, the most unusual is a soft gray tweed mixture with a blue stripe which gives the 1949 Ford interior a freshly tailored look.

The same tailored good looks are obtained with the other fabrics—a smooth green striped broadcloth and two new adaptations of mohair in a green and maroon stripe and green and gray stripe combination. In proper combination, they complement the new Ford exterior colors such as Sea Mist Green, Birch Gray, Arabian Green and Bayview Blue.

The instrument panel of the new Ford has been simplified. All instruments are combined in a single cluster directly in line with the driver's view. Projecting slightly for better visibility, the large figures on a telescoped dial indicate speed, fuel level, rate of battery charge and oil pressure. The clock dial has been centered on the panel and placed higher. Night glare is eliminated on all instruments by "black lighting."

The chrome trim throughout the car has been reduced. On the panel it is expressed in a neat arrangement of uniform knobs which control choke, windshield wiper, lights, heater and defroster. On each door, the chrome strip makes a decorative arc over the heavy artificial leather kick pad at the bottom. Interior door handles pull up instead of down to open

The door. This eliminates the possibility of the car doors swinging open if the handle should be pressed down accidentally. The new Ford's functionality has been extended to the roomy seats—57 inches wide in front and 60 inches in the rear, plenty of room for six persons.

New windows demonstrate the trend. The rear window alone is 88 per cent larger—as large as the ordinary windshield. The windshield is deeper and wider. They give a picture window effect to the entire car and greatly improve all around visibility.

Order Sewers East of City
