

Two thousand persons are expected to attend the formal opening today of Torrance Town Homes, the first unit of which includes 47 two bedroom homes at no down payment for veterans.

The development is located at Torrance boulevard and Western avenue.

A fast sale of this initial unit is anticipated because the average size of the dwellings is larger than most two-bedroom homes now coming onto the market, the builders claim.

Town Homes, which vary in size from 785 to 904 square feet, are priced from \$7430 to \$8050 to veterans on combination FHA and GI terms.

The development is conveniently located to the downtown business district of Torrance, and to numerous employment places.

To provide a variety of appearance to the development, the builders are introducing five new basic plans and 12 different elevations, each with a two-car attached or detached garage.
