LIGHT YEAST ROLLS 1/2 C. scalded milk 1/2 C. cake compressed yeast 1/2 C. sugar 1 tsp. salt 1 egg, well beaten 7 Tbsp. sifted flour (approx.) 3 Tbsp. salad oil or melted shortening

Scald milk and set aside to cool to lukewarm. Crumble yeast into a large mixing bowl. Add sugar, salt and lukewarm milk. (Be sure to check the temperature because liquid that's too hot will destroy the yeast.) Add well beaten egg.

DIFFERENT FABRICS REQUIRE VARYING IRONING METHODS

Your ironing can be easier and your clothes will look better if you remember that different fabrics require different ironing temperatures and degrees of dampness, say homemaking experts of the General Electric Consumers Institute.

Although some garments come from the store with laundering instructions attached, there are many that do not carry this information. To help with these several housewives, the General Consumers Institute makes the following recommendations for ironing various fabrics.

COTTONS: Light colored cottons should be ironed right side out, dark colors should be ironed on the wrong side to prevent a shine. Smooth, sheer cottons (voile, for example) should be ironed while quite damp; they can be ironed immediately after they have been removed from the automatic washer. Heavier cottons like shirting and gingham may be ironed from a quite moist to a slightly damp state, depending upon the iron or ironing board used.

Woolen fabrics: Woolen fabrics should be ironed on the wrong side. They should be ironed while damp, but not too wet. They should be ironed immediately after they have been removed from the automatic washer. Heavier woolens like shirting and gingham may be ironed from a quite moist to a slightly damp state, depending upon the iron or ironing board used.

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Wool Jerseys are WARM, WORSTED, AND WONDERFUL FOR FALL

The lamb of Fallwinter wardrobe perennials, wool jersey, has some new teeth this season. Wool jersey has gone "worsted" in a big way. Introduced by a collection of "Worsted Jersey Pair-Offs" coordinated separately by Stephanie Koret, who creates those famous California casuals, the versatile qualities of the fabric make for new and exciting use in style.

"Worsted" is a longer staple yarn that is finer than short-napped wool. Worsted jersey is "fringed spun," or woven on a circular machine for additional strength. Two special qualities identify worsted jersey from wool jersey. One is the weight; worsted jersey is very sheer, wool near a chiffon weight. The second distinguishing quality is its "spring." Worsted jersey has what is called "tenacity," or a greater capacity for retaining its original shape, and a minimizer of any sag or stretch.

Among the demure classics in worsted jersey is Stephanie Koret's collection are two blouses that receive special attention because they seal all the limits of sunniness-to-sunset wear. One is a heather beige blouse with sloping shoulders and short-cuffed sleeves in contrasting, syrup brown that are cord-stitched for firmness. A delicate shawl collar on this blouse plunges to a low point of the bodice. The other blouse is a luxurious, wing-sleeved worsted jersey with a jewel neckline. The simple, effective trim is a sunburst of tiny fagoting lines that follow an elliptical curve.

Both blouses go casual with a shirred worsted jersey skirt with one inverted, unpressed pleat. They dress up for evening with an exciting flared skirt that is banded with velvet. Satin and brocade skirts for evening are important with this type of "understated" bodice in worsted jersey. A classic in this collection that will probably get the biggest sorority rush of the season is a slim, controlled skirt that fans out and around in a cascade of inch-thin accordion pleats. The pleats are "baked" into the fabric by an exclusive Koret method. The result is a skirt that retains its original shape during long and hard wear. From this side of the fashion fence, it looks like the wool jersey that's "worsted" will be a winner all season long!
