Atom Film to be Shown At Hammerton Tract Church

Hammerton Tract Community Church again will show another one of Moody Bible Institute of Science Pictures, Sunday evening January 1, 7:30 p.m. at the church, 2620 Elliot avenue.

The mysterious atom—smallest particle of an element—will be discussed in the natural color film, "God of the Atom."

Approved by the American Scientific Affiliation and commended by the Atomic Energy Commission, "God of the Atom" includes actual photographs of the Nagasaki and Bikini explosions, as well as scientific ap-

paratus used in atomic research. Narration is by preacher-scientist Irwin A. Moon, famous for his "Sermons from Science" demonstrations during World War II. Larry Johnston, a young physicist who aided in atomic development at Los Alamos and photographed all three wartime bombs as they exploded, appears in the film with an eye-witness account of his experiences. "Man needs the kind of help which, in my experience, only 'God' can give," says the scientist, adding "For me, this is no academic statement, but an experimental truth."

The film is one of a series including "Voice of the Deep" and "God of Creation," produced by Moody Bible Institute of Chicago. It will be shown by a Moody film representative.

The film will be shown at Harbor General Hospital. Also on Monday, boys of the Hammerton Tract church will present toys to hospitalized children.

Methodists Plan Two Yule Services

Adult Classes More Popular

Average daily attendance of adult classes for November was 66 percent over the same period last year, according to Donald Manshaw, director of Torrance School of Adult Education.
