All-Year Club Elects Auditor Advisory Head

Logan R. Cotton, Torrance city auditor, was elected general chairman of the County Advisory Council of the All-Year Club this week.

This advisory council is composed of business and civic leaders throughout Los Angeles County who help formulate policies of the All-Year Club which binds most of its efforts toward luring to Southern California tourists and tourist dollars.

Don Thomas, managing director of the club, told the council at the election meeting that a total of 2,841,885 tourists came into California last year and stayed an average of 19.2 days each.

"That's an average of 150,000 tourists in the state every day," he said. "That's a city larger than Sacramento composed of entirely of out-of-state visitors."
