"This class is geared to solve the personal problems of machinists, electricians, plumbers, carpenters, contractors, and others who must understand blueprints, rough sketches, and slide rule work to help them advance in their jobs," Nash said.

"Because of the personal nature of the course, beginning or advanced students may benefit by individual instruction," he said. "Machinists can aid their promotion to toolmakers and other key jobs by learning to read and draft prints on jigs, fixtures and parts. Electricians can learn to read and make wiring diagrams to building code specifications. Plumbers can advance to journeymen and master plumbers by knowing how to read blueprints. Carpenters and contractors can look to increase in pay and less laborious work by learning how to put up structures according to plans."
