Registration will be held July 5 and classes are scheduled to begin Thursday, July 6. Any high school graduate or person over 18 is eligible to enroll in any class offered.

Classes under the shop program will hold meetings during the mornings from 9 o'clock to noon because of the warm weather. Courses offered include auto mechanics, body and fender work, repair and painting, radio maintenance and repair, furniture and cabinet making, carpentry, engineering and machine drawing.

Two classes will be offered for people interested in agriculture. Hours may be arranged individually for class meetings.

ings. Offered are conferences and projects in poultry and horticulture. For the benefit of adults already in the field of agriculture, an additional course is offered; poultry raising and production, to be held each Monday evening from 6 to 10 o'clock.
