**CITY GETS \$42,481 FROM FEES**

Based on a population figure which was proved by the recent census to be approximately 5000 short of the city's actual population, Torrance will receive \$42,481.92 as its share of the 1950 Motor Vehicle License Fees, according to City Clerk A. H. Bartlett.

When the new population figure of 22,201, the official census figure for Torrance is used as a basis of computation, the apportionment should be increased by approximately \$10,000, Bartlett estimated.

**America's Most Unique City Has No Jails, Taxes**

There exists at least one city in America that has no worry about taxes, jails or a police force, according to a letter received this week by J. A. Evans, secretary of Torrance Moose Lodge 785.

Writing to the lodge about this unique city was Mrs. Harry B. Lewis, widow of the first secretary of Torrance Chamber of Commerce.

"The tiny community of Mooseheart, Ill., has no taxes, no jails, no police force—and no need for any of them," Mrs. Lewis wrote. "Mooseheart is the city of children, the only one of its size anywhere."

Mrs. Lewis and her two children, Patricia and Harry Jr., now live in the model village. She is studying child psychology and teaching in the kindergarten there, she reports. She and the children were certified to the home earlier this year by the Torrance lodge.

"Mooseheart has its own post office, fire department, schools, stores, laundry, hospital, filling station and a cannery," she wrote to the Torrance lodge.

Mooseheart was organized in 1913 under the direction of the late Senator James J. Davis of Pennsylvania. It is operated by the Loyal Order of Moose for dependent children of deceased members.


