Albert N. Posner, administrative assistant in charge of personnel, said last Thursday that 14 elementary teacher vacancies still existed in the local system.

This is in spite of a favorable salary schedule maintained by the local Board of Education. Posner said that the salary for local teachers compares very favorably with most school districts in Los Angeles County.

Experienced teachers of the third, fourth, and fifth grade level may apply for one of the 14 positions by calling at district headquarters, 2335 Plaza del Amo any day between 8:15 and 4:30 p. m.

All other positions for school opening in the fall have been filled, Posner said.


