


Do's and Don'ts For Dogs and Dollies

It'll Be A Rough Life For Rover

Leading a dog's life, once the epitome of a miserable existence, is going to be even rougher from here on in.

Prompted by numerous complaints, South Bay Humane Society officials said this week that owners of loose dogs would be given a "ticket" for violation of the city's leash law.

According to Mrs. Bernice Blomk, operator of Torrance's "pound" no more warnings would be issued to dog owners whose dogs were found not fenced in or on a five-foot leash.

"The fact that a dog is on the owner's property does not exempt the owner from the law," Mrs. Blomk said.

Fines range from \$5—and up! "We have been writing warnings for the past eight years. As a result we have had as many as 150 dogs in the kennels in one time. Too, we have had hundreds of complaints of stray dogs from citizens in Torrance," Mrs. Blomk said.

She said that all dogs, whether on a leash or penned up must have a city license. Dog tags may be purchased from the city clerk or from the South Bay Humane Society, 20336 Earl street.

Price of the tags are \$2 for males and spayed females and \$3 for non-spayed females.

She also reminded local dog owners that 1950 dog licenses were due as of July 1.

NAVY TELLS RESERVES ABOUT RE-ENLISTMENT

If you are a Naval Reservist and want to get active duty, Captain M. W. Graybill, USN, Officer-in-Charge of the Office of Naval Officer Procurement and the Los Angeles Naval Recruiting District, has some suggestions to offer.

1. If you are an officer, apply directly to the Bureau of Naval Personnel, (Pers B-11), Navy Department, Washington 25, D. C.

2. If you are an enlisted man, visit your nearest Recruiting Station.

3. Be sure you are in one of the categories listed below.

As announced by the Navy Department, male Naval Reserve officers and enlisted personnel are desired for active duty on a voluntary basis for general assignment primarily afloat and overseas for an obligated period of not less than six months and a guaranteed period of one year.

Captain Graybill, whose office answered hundreds of queries today from prospective volunteers, pointed out that officers of unrestricted line, both aviation, and non-aviation, supply corps, dental corps and civil engineer corps in the grades of lieutenant commander and below were desired. In addition, he added, officers of the medical corps and a limited number of line officers who are specialists in electronics, communications and intelligence in the grades of commander and below are needed to fill active duty billets. Aviation officers, he pointed out, should indicate their flight time during the

must be in the following reserve categories: V1 (enlisted personnel associated with service units of the organized reserve), V2 (enlisted personnel associated with aviation units of the organized reserve), V3 (enlisted personnel who are attached to volunteer electronics companies and platoons) V6 (enlisted personnel required for mobilization in addition to the other categories of the volunteer Reserve program), O1 (enlisted personnel attached to organized surface units), and O2 (enlisted personnel attached to organized aviation units).


Captain Graybill said that men volunteering "must be physically qualified for unlimited active duty and have at least one year of obligated service."

Volunteers, if accepted, will be transferred to the nearest receiving station for processing and assignment to duty.


