Evelyn Potter Coles of 1738 1/2 Manuel avenue has announced her resignation as piano teacher at the Gardena High School.



She said she would devote her time to teaching piano privately in her home here. She was formerly associated with Abby De Avirett of Long Beach, and will teach beginners and advanced students.
