A new name is being engraved on the Torrance Herald Perpetual Trophy this week. In ceremonies climaxing a playoff for the title of "Industrial League Champions of 1950," Manager Fred Montgomery of the winning Lovelady team stepped up and took over the beautiful, 18-inch trophy for his team.
Lovelady had downed National Supply 8-2 in the third game of a two-out-of-three playoff, becoming the third team in three years to take possession of the championship trophy.

Beginning the playoff last Thursday evening, the 1950 champs got an edge in the series by downing National Supply 8 to 4.
The game had hardly resumed when a National Supply player and a heckler were squaring off behind the grandstand. No blows were struck, and the game went on peacefully.
