


Camino Horticulturists Schedule Flower Show

Dangers Told of Hysteria Buying

"Hysteria buying will do nothing for the customer but raise prices," so warned John Almond, president of the Torrance Better Merchants this week. Almond, owner of the Almond Department Store, warned local residents against the danger of buying unneeded goods and hoarding merchandise.

"I honestly feel that there is no cause for alarm over shortages at the present time. The nation's industries are not operating at full capacity and are producing far below their capabilities. The only shortages which will occur will be caused by hoarding, which merely transfers the goods from the merchant's shelves to the consumer's closet," he said.

"The consumer who 'suits away' merchandise will find he has accomplished nothing but to raise the price on himself. This is true even in merchandise of an entirely different nature. For instance, a shortage of overalls brought about by hoarding will cause the price
