Flying Executive Wins Gold Wins

Henry W. Creeger, head man at the American Standard Corporation, won his wings this week.

The manager of the huge Crenshaw boulevard pottery plant had his lapel decorated with a pair of gold wings by a pretty stewardess from the United Air Lines in honor of his completion of more than 100,000 miles of airline travel.

Handed him also by Miss Millie Sturdevant was a gold membership card in the "100,000 Mile Club" and a plaque for the office wall.

Creeger has made at least 15 air trips across the U. S. and at least 43 round trips from Oakland to Torrance since he joined American Standard 40 years ago. His first flight was made in 1929 in one of the famous tri-motored Ford monoplanes. He has never flown in what he would say is rough weather and has only been grounded once during his 21 years of riding the airplanes.

The executive's plaque was signed by W. A. Patterson, president of United Air Lines, and was given "in appreciation of your valuable contribution to air transportation progress."

USC Student Honored By Foundation

Gerard E. Stavish, 20713 1/2 South Vermont avenue, has been awarded a partial scholarship in physical therapy under the nationwide professional training program of the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis, L. Dee Beveal, California representative for the foundation, announced this week.

Stavish is one of 131 California residents to receive a scholarship since the national foundation expanded its physical therapy program in 1945 to help combat a critical shortage of qualified personnel in the physical therapy field.

THERAPISTS NEEDED

While 1343 scholarships have been awarded to date through the national foundation alone, it is estimated that 15,000 physical therapists are needed to meet the ever-increasing demand for their highly skilled professional services. Since the first physical therapy appropriation of \$55,000 was made in 1942, the organization has allocated more than \$2,000,000 March of Dimes funds to support the program.

Stavish is studying at University of Southern California, one of many schools and institutions throughout the country approved for this type of training by the American Medical Association's Council on Medical Education and Hospitals.
