

## CAMINO OFFERS AUTO BODY, FENDER COURSES

Four to six years' experience in two! That is the possibility offered students enrolling in El Camino College's auto body and fender course next fall.

Completion of the college's two-year shop program will equip the student with knowledge and skills that would require from four to six years of work as an apprentice, according to instructor Rex Baumgardner, who declares that the field offers many excellent job opportunities.

With the opening of college September 14, the auto body and fender program will begin its second semester with an offering of both day and evening classes. The evening class is designed to meet the needs of beginners as well as the requirements of workers already in the

field who wish to develop new skills.

### TWO TERMS OFFERED

Two full semesters of work will be offered regularly enrolled day students next fall, and additional advanced courses will be added within the next year, enabling majors in the field to complete work for the Associate of Arts degree in two years.

Work in the beginning first year class will cover the fundamentals of oxy-acetylene welding, basic sheet metal, fender repair and replacement, door fitting, glass replacing, auto body manufacture, and beginning painting.

Third and fourth semester students will learn advanced sheet metal, how to replace unit body panels, upholstery repair,

body repair and alignment, frame straightening, lacquer and enamel auto painting, and repair estimation.

### SPECIAL TRAINING

Upon completion of the two-year course a student will be trained for a variety of positions in auto factories, assembly plants, sheet metal shops, auto agencies, general auto repair shops, and for specialized work in glass, metal and upholstery. Help in getting suitable jobs will be given graduates.

Facilities for the body and fender classes have been completed recently and offer the most modern equipment, including spray guns, power machinery, and a dust-free spray booth.

**EXPERIENCED INSTRUCTOR**  
Instructor Baumgardner has had more than 16 years' experience

in the trade and has worked with all of the major automobiles manufactured. For five years he served as service manager and shop foreman with various large auto repair shops. Enrollment for the fall semester at the college is scheduled for September 11, 12 and 13. Classes are open without tuition charge to anyone 18 years of age or older and to high school graduates regardless of age.

## National Electric Corp. Creates New Sales Area




