

Koussevitzky to Conduct Hollywood Bowl Finale.

Hollywood Bowl's 29th season of Symphonies Under the Stars will end with a grand climax. Beethoven's majestic and joyful Symphony No. 9 in D Minor with soloists and chorus will be performed September 5, final night of the summer series.

Serge Koussevitzky, one of the foremost conductors in the world, will conduct the last four concerts of the 1950 season: August 29, 31 and September 3 and 5. Last summer the noted maestro attracted 24,000 persons in two concerts.

For his soloists Koussevitzky will have three notables of the concert world among instrumentalists and a strong group of singers for the Beethoven 9th.

An all-Tschalkowsky program August 29 features Violinist Isaac Stern and the Concerto in D Major besides Symphony No. 5 in E Minor. Vladimir Horowitz, world renowned pianist, will play the Concerto No. 3 by Rachmaninoff on a program with the Brahms Concerto, No. 1 in C Minor, August 31, and an all-Beethoven event September 3 with Heifetz playing the D Major Concerto.

For the 9th symphony Koussevitzky will have the following soloists: Marina Koshetz, soprano; Janice Moudry, contralto; Thomas Hayward, tenor; James Pease, bass, and the Los Angeles opera and concerto chorus combined with the Greater Los Angeles Chorus, Hugo Stre-

litzer, director. On the program with the famous 9th will be two cantatas by Johann Sebastian Bach: the No. 12 and No. 50, commemorating the 200th anniversary of the death of the great master.
