

Dedication Services Set For Rebuilt Parish Hall

Dedication services for the newly-remodeled parish hall of First Lutheran Church will be held Sunday afternoon, Sept. 3, at 3 o'clock at the church, corner of Acacia and Sonoma, according to Pastor Paul Wenske.
Pastor William Lange of Compton, one of the organizers of the church, will give the sermon. His theme will be: "The Lutheran Parish Hall—A Christian Workshop." Other pastors from the surrounding churches will also take part in the service.
Greetings from the California District will be given by the district president, Dr. K. O. Knudsen. Musical numbers will be given by the Senior Choir, under the direction of Charles Bartholomew, and also by the Youth Choir directed by Mrs. Paul Wenske. Mrs. Joe Bay will be the organist.
The parish hall consists of the main hall which has been newly plastered, painted, and the floors covered with asphalt tile. Larger windows have been added to this room. The lighting is of the fluorescent type.
Connected to the main hall is a Youth Room which will be used entirely by teenagers for Sunday school and other activities.
Next to the ladies' rest room is a powder room which can also be used for weddings. The kitchen has been entirely repaired and made more efficient. Plans are being made to purchase a new stove for the kitchen. In the near future the present parsonage will be used for Sunday school rooms and the entire yard will be used for youth development programs.
Oliver Minniear, a member of the church, was the contractor for the building.
