


## Gardena C of C Hosts Chambers

## Fair to Depict New Fly Control Measures in Use

"Control of the common house fly is largely the responsibility of the individual householder and business man," Dr. Roy O. Gilbert, Los Angeles County health officer, declared yesterday.

Really effective control can be made possible only through community-wide programs which enlist the efforts of each person to practice basic sanitation measures on whatever property he owns or occupies for any purpose, he doctor said.

What these measures are, will be depicted in the exhibit of the County Health Department in the Hall of Health at the Los Angeles County Fair opening September 15 in Pomona.

A huge model fly is being constructed as the central element in the exhibit. Twenty other health agencies, including the State and City health departments, Community Chest agencies and the major independently supported health organizations, are installing exhibits in the Hall of Health in the Grand Stand building at the Fair Grounds.

More than 6000 square feet of exhibits and demonstrations are under construction. A motion picture theater is also being built in order to bring the latest medical and scientific information to the public.

The Hall of Health is financed by the County Board of Supervisors, the Los Angeles City Council and certain voluntary health associations.
