





Frank Vanderlip New President Of P.V. Group

The Palos Verdes Corporation announced today that Kelvin C. Vanderlip, corporation president since 1944, had resigned and that he has been succeeded by his brother, Frank A. Vanderlip Jr.

The corporation, owner of 7000 acres of Palos Verdes Peninsula land, is engaged primarily in the real estate, farming and mining business.

Frank Vanderlip, New York and Washington businessman, and Corporation vice president until his promotion to the presidency, took over active management of the Corporation today.

He announced that there will be no changes in fundamental policies for the long-range, orderly development of Palos Verdes. Jack B. Beardwood and Harold H. Streight will remain as Corporation vice presidents.

Kelvin Vanderlip will remain as a member of the Board of Directors and is being retained, in an advisory capacity, by the new president.

He will devote his outside time to new business opportunities and will continue to make his home in Portuguese Bend.

In announcing Kelvin Vanderlip's resignation, Board Chairman Harry E. Benedict of New York City pointed out that since Kelvin Vanderlip took over management six years ago, the Corporation has opened 13 new subdivisions, done over \$3,000,000 in real estate business, developed the Portuguese Bend section of the Palos Verdes Peninsula, built the Portuguese Bend Club and expanded ranching operations so they currently involve approximately 400 acres in 17 privately built homes in the \$12,000 to \$80,000 class under construction.

Frank A. Vanderlip, Jr., is the eldest son of the late New York financier who headed the National City Bank. Upon graduation from Harvard University in 1930, with Bachelor of Arts Degrees in both Agriculture and Economics, he joined Vanderlip's Guaranty Trust Company of New York City for further financial training and business experience. In 1931 he joined his father's office and specialized in corporate financing and re-financing, including being on the Board and a member of the executive committee of the Rec Motor Company.

Going to Washington in 1940, Vanderlip became Assistant Coordinator of Defense Housing. In 1942 he joined the United States Army as a Captain and was assigned to the Australian-New Zealand Supply Mission. Later, he served in Africa, Italy, France and Germany. He was demobilized in 1946 as a lieutenant colonel.

From 1936 to 1948, Vanderlip was Assistant to the Chairman of the Board of Trans-World Airlines and was in charge of organizing the affiliated Middle East Airlines. Since leaving TWA, he has been in the Vanderlip New York office handling a general venture capital business.

Vanderlip is establishing his home in the Portuguese Bend area of the Palos Verdes Peninsula.

Unreality of Death Sunday Science Sermon

"Are Sin, Disease, and Death Real?" This question will be the Sunday lesson-sermon subject in all branches of the Mother Church, the First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston. The Golden Text is from the Psalms: "Salvation belongeth unto thy Lord: Thy blessing is upon Thy people."

It is recorded in The Acts that when the disciples told Peter that Dorcas was dead, he "arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber; and all the widows stood by him weeping... But Peter put them all forth, and knelt down, and prayed; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes; and when she saw Peter, she sat up... And when he had called the saints and widows, presented her alive."
