

That Dream House Can Come True If You Attend This New Class

Individual needs of students in designing and drawing plans for their "dream home" will receive consideration at a new class in home planning and home building now being offered at the Torrance Adult Evening School.

First session of the class was held last Thursday evening at 7 until 10 o'clock in room 106, and was under the direction of Ivan Malm, instructor.

BLUEPRINT READING

For those who want to build their own garage, or add a room to their own home, Malm will show the student how to work with contractors, architects, and how to comply with building specifications. Students will learn to read simple blueprints and specifications, so that they can design on paper and know ahead of time exactly what the finished product will be.

Top specialists in home building will be brought into the classes from time to time, such as the city building inspector, electrical contractors, painters and plasterers. Malm plans to spend some time on the escrow—how to understand the escrow, and how to have a trouble-free escrow. It is his plan to bring in a real estate or escrow official to answer questions of the group. They will study different types of construction and materials, and learn the most efficient and inexpensive methods of building.

HELP FOR AMATEUR

Dominant theme of the course is to help the amateur builder to get the most out of his money. "It is a simple thing," said Malm, "to make your dreams come true by designing your bathroom and kitchen the way you have always wanted them to be, and to make provision for that extra cozy den and bedrooms with good exposure. Anyone who is serious enough can learn to build his own home. I have seen hundreds of people do just this, and I expect in this class a lot

more will follow."

Any adult, regardless of residence, may attend this free class by registering on Thursday night, Oct. 12, in room 106 of Torrance High School.
