


# TODAY'S MAGIC by Hancock

1. MOST IMPROMPTU CARD TRICKS HAVE TO DO WITH FINDING A CARD THAT HAS BEEN CHOSEN AT RANDOM AND RETURNED TO THE DECK.



3. AS SOON AS A CARD IS CHOSEN, THE MAGICIAN TURNS THE DECK AROUND BEFORE THE SELECTED CARD IS RETURNED.

4. THE CARD IS EASILY LOCATED BY THE TRICKSTER FROM EITHER END OF THE DECK. AT ONE END THE BREAK IN THE DRAWN LINE INDICATES THE CARD. AT THE OTHER END THE DOT WILL SHOW WHERE THE SELECTED CARD HAS BEEN PLACED.

# Tartars Set For Oilers

## El Segundo to Invade Tartarville Tomorrow

Tartar Coaches Rex Welch and Cliff Graybehl have been busy this week preparing their charges for two things that they say will become evident tomorrow night.

First—that the El Segundo Oilers, who visit here for the Tartars' fourth Bay League III tomorrow night, are going to field a better team than most.

Second—that the Oilers are going to give the Tartars no trouble with the spread formation they will throw at the local gridders.

On the first count, it has been generally conceded that a strong Redondo team beat the Oilers last week on breaks of the game. The main weakness of the El Segundo squad is a lack of depth.

**SPREAD USED**  
 On the second count, their use of a spread formation on offense makes the game a wide-open affair. One or two breaks with a pass receiver getting beyond the defense and the Tartars will be in trouble.

"This is not going to be any Wiener-bake," according to Welch.

The coaches, fans, team members and everyone else at the Leuzinger game had nothing but fine words for the showing made by Chuggin' Charlie Camon. Filling Danny Dandoy's left half spot when Dandoy moved to quarterback, Chuggin' Charlie showed some of the boys how a ball-packer should operate.
