### Western Union to Begin Service Here in New Office Wednesday

Thousands of American cities will be brought "next door" to Torrance next Wednesday when the Western Union opens telegraph service for this area at its new offices at 1915 West Carson street.

Through the magic of the company's "electric brain," the city of Torrance will be only a push-button away from nearly all the cities of the nation, according to J. W. Inwood, superintendent of the company.

The opening of the new offices will mean the facilities which have existed at the Pacific Electric depot here will be discontinued, Inwood said.

Messages going and coming from the new Torrance office will clear through the "brain," which is in Los Angeles. Called an "automatic selective switching system," the electronic clearing house will send a message to any of thousands of cities in the United States, according to the prefix put on the message, much like a dial telephone.

With the opening of the offices here next week, adequate telegraph service for the Torrance area will be available for the first time, according to Inwood.
