Chairman Attends Meet

Mrs. Harry Kaempfer, health chairman of Lomita-San Pedro PTA Council, attended the Tenth District PTA Red Cross Workshop Wednesday in Los Angeles and reported that the district will set up its own Group Participation Blood Bank Plan. This provides that participating groups have a blood savings account with the Red Cross Center equal to the amount of blood contributed by its members.

All members of the PTA and their immediate families whether they have been able to contribute or not are eligible in times of need to draw upon the credit established by their organization. After the first contribution, the Red Cross sends the donor an identification card giving his or her blood type and the Rh factor. In an emergency, this information is immediately available to doctors and hospitals.
