



Dictaphone Classes To Be Started Jan. 4

A new adult class that will handle instruction in the operation of the dictaphone (dictating machine) for typists who can type an average of forty words per minute or more, was announced by Mack Landar, instructor of the course. This class will be held each Monday and Wednesday evening from 8 to 9:30 in room 205 of Torrance Evening High School, starting Wednesday evening, January 4.

Dictaphone instruction is part of the regular typing class conducted by Landar. As he points out: "It is a distinct advantage for typists to be able to operate the dictaphone—an advantage in greater income, greater choice of good positions, and more security." Adults may go directly to room 205 on Wednesday evening to register.




