Business and personnel offices of the college moved into the new building about two weeks ago.

Shared for construction sometime this fall is the new swimming pool, plans for which are being hurried to completion. Plans for a library are nearing the completed stage, and construction will start in the near future.

ENROLLMENT STABLE No major changes in enrollment are anticipated for the fall semester, according to Sloan. Enrollment figures are expected between 3200 and 3500 students—about the same as the 1950 figure.

Any increases will probably be reflected in the adult school program, Sloan said. Several new vocational and technical courses are being added to the curriculum this fall and other departments learning are being expanded.



It should be enough of all ages, but especially so for teenagers. Both boys and girls of this age have high food requirements—higher than those of their parents or younger brothers and sisters.


It should provide variety. Each individual lunch should contain a variety of foods from every one of the four food groups. This is important both for appetite and for good nutrition.
