Tuesday Night Blueprint Class Open to Adults

A new free adult class in blueprinting will be held each Tuesday night at 7 o'clock in room 104 of Torrance High School. This class is open to all adults, regardless of experience.

Both beginning and advanced students are invited to join this group. Instructor Camille Benson, a local designer for the Cal-National Corporation, will explain some phases of blueprinting that the students actually use on the job. Each unit of instruction comprises three parts: a study library sheet, an accompanying job sheet, and an arrangement sheet. A basic text provides fundamental material for students, appliances, craftsmen in the machine and allied trades.

Emphasis is on simple practical everyday blueprint reading and mechanical drawing that pay dividends in salary and promotion.


