

Torrance Minister To Visit Formosa

Rev. J. Russell Killman, assistant pastor of the First Baptist Church here, has announced plans to spend two months on the island of Formosa near Japan early next year under the auspices of the Youth for Christ movement.

The young minister, who has been active in the youth movement since its beginning, will leave here by Philippine Airlines February 2, he said.

He will fly to Formosa by way of Honolulu, Guam, Wake and Manila. The entire air trip will take about 41 hours, Rev. Killman said.

GOVERNOR AGREES

Letters from the island's governor, Casi Wco, will introduce the minister to principals of schools who will assemble students to hear the message, he said. He will travel with an interpreter.

"Usually, the Youth for Christ sends musical teams into an area, like this along with a minister," Rev. Killman said. However, inasmuch as Rev. Killman is an accomplished trumpet player and singer, he will be a "one-man team," he says.

TO VISIT TROOPS

An introduction note from Generalissimo Chiang Kai-Shek will grant him entry to Free China troop camps where he will preach during the two months on the island, the minister said. He plans to preach four times a day during his visit on Formosa.

The trip is being financed locally with members of the church, Torrance merchants and others contributing to the travel fund.

Reverend Killman will return by way of Okinawa, Japan, Alaska and Seattle. His family will remain here while he makes the Far East trip, he said.
