

## Episcopal Plans Xmas Eve Service

St. Andrew's Episcopal Church will continue in its tradition of having Christmas eve services this year. Candlelight services will be held at 9:30 and at 11:15. In addition there will be a Christmas Day service at 10:00 a.m.

At the 11:15 p.m. service the service the Boys Choir, under the direction of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Evans, will join the Girls Choir which is under the direction of the parish organist, Miss Amy Bourquin. The combined choir will sing carols and in addition the Boys Choir will sing some special carols which have not been heard previously in this area of California. Rev. Arthur E. Bello will preach the Christmas sermon "God So Loved the World."

At the 11:15 p.m. services the Chancel Choir under the direction of Miss Amy Bourquin will sing the Choral Eucharist service. This choir will also sing the traditional carols and hymns. The rector will preach on the topic "Christmas Assurance."

## Atomic Force Is Christian Science Sermon

"And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth." This selection from the gospel of John (1:14) in the King James version of the Bible will be read as a part of the lesson-sermon in all Christian Science churches Sunday.

The subject will be "Is the Universe, Including Man, Evolved by Atomic Force?" The golden text from I Corinthians declares, "To us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by Him" (8:6).

A correlative sermon selection from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy reads, "Jesus' spiritual origin and understanding enabled him to demonstrate the facts of being—to prove irrefutably how spiritual truth destroys material error, heals sickness and overcomes death. The divine conception of Jesus pointed to this truth and presented an illustration of creation" (p. 315).
