Small Audience Hears TUTmen In Beach Area

An audience of 23 persons, including eight from Hollywood Riviera, heard the three TUT candidates outline their platform for the forthcoming city council race during a meeting held last Friday night in the Riviera Beach Club.

Al Iken, one of the candidates, told the rather scattered audience during the meeting that he could see "no earthly reason" for not annexing Alondra Park and renaming El Camino College the "Torrance City College."

Tuesday night the Board of Trustees of the college took a stand against annexation by any city on the grounds that such a move would hamper greatly the future development of the school.

Frank Brennan, chairman of the meeting, refused to admit questions from the floor stating that the meeting was not an open meeting but an organizational meeting. He said he would answer questions regarding the organization providing the queries were from residents of the Hollywood Riviera section only.

The meeting was opened by Frank S. Selover, president of the group, who read a copy of the articles of incorporation. Iken told the group it was his opinion that the present city council was the poorest council the city had ever had and that three former mayors, J. Hugh Sherkey, William Tolson and Bill Stanger, all agreed with him.

Speaking also were the two other members of the TUT club, et Victor Benstead and Councilman Nick Draie.

To be installed as the first commander is Joyce Cole. Beatrice Bundy, 1825 Cabrillo, will be installed as the first vice-commander.

George Beal, commander of the South Bay Post 184, will deliver the welcoming address. J. H. Chillington, national field representative for the American Legion and a former Army chaplain, will serve as installation chairman.

John C. Dunn, commander of the Fourth Area, Department of California, will be the speaker of the evening.

Among the distinguished guests at the ceremonies will be Hope Kennedy of San Francisco, vice-commander for women, Department of California, and her aide Edith White of Torrance.

The post is being organized with 23 charter members from the Torrance-South Bay area.
