## Board's Action Asked On Bonds

Bonds totaling \$2,400,000 will be offered for sale by the County of Los Angeles, starting in May, provided the Board of Supervisors gives its approval to a request of the Torrance Board of Education.

The bonds are part of a \$3,000,000 school bond issue voted last month here to provide additional schools and educational facilities.

Although sold on and after May 2, the certificates will be dated June 2, it was said.

## Shell Growth Program Told

A \$5,000,000 expansion program at the Shell Oil Refinery in the Carson-Dominguez area will start at once, R. W. McOmble, manager of the local plant, announced this week.

McOmble said that a crude oil distillation unit, a p a h a t of processing 20,000 barrels per day will be built to replace two Trumble type distillation units erected first in 1923.

Total output then will be about 86,000 barrels of refined products per day, he stated.

The building program is part of a \$100,000,000 expansion move throughout the United States now being undertaken by Shell. When all projects are complete, more than 4,000,000 barrels per day of refined products will be added to the nation's output.




