

Home Building Sets Fast Pace in April

Home building continued to set a fast pace here during April as the total construction permits issued neared the \$2,000,000 mark for the month, figures of the city's building department show.

Total value of permits issued during April was \$1,964,246 as compared to a total of \$1,209,988 during April last year. The month's activity brought

the year's total to \$6,488,037. Last year at the end of April the total stood at \$4,873,568.

Allied Gardens led the parade with permits for 174 new homes valued at \$1,412,936. Permits for about 30 more homes will be issued to the developers right away.

Also expected in the next week or two are permits for 129 homes to be built by the January Co. at Pacific Coast Hwy. and Crenshaw Blvd. Heavy equipment has been on the site during the week grading the area.

Other smaller developments are also due, city officials say.

Humane Society Operator Shot In Suicide Try

Ralph Blonk, operator of the South Bay Humane Society, yesterday was reported "fair-though still on the critical list" at Harbor General Hospital following a suicide attempt at his home, 20362 Earl St., late Wednesday night.

Blonk, who reportedly had

been very despondent over a lingering illness which had forced him to be confined to his bed, fired a .32 caliber bullet into his chest, barely missing his heart, sheriff's deputies report.

The 43-year-old war veteran was called to his wife from his bedroom, asking her to play his favorite piece on an organ, Mrs. Blonk told officers.

When his wife told him she was busy with guests at the moment he said: "You just don't care for me any more." She heard a shot, and rushed into the bedroom.

Blonk was taken to Harbor General Hospital.
