would have little use as a public facility. The college is located on 90 acres of land on the southeast corner of Alondra Park at Redondo Beach and Crenshaw Blvds.

Since its conception in 1946, the college has completed an administration-classroom unit, a gymnasium, a field house, shop building, a warehouse, a student union building including a cafeteria, and a stadium now capable of seating 7000 persons with an ultimate capacity of 20,000 persons. Cost of the completed structures amounts to \$4,234,000.

Under the present plan, when the school is completed it will be housed in permanent structures and will be free and clear of indebtedness.

Voting on the issue will be the communities of Inglewood, Lennox, Hawthorne, Lavndale, El Segundo, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, Redondo Beach and the intervening county areas within the district.

In two of the districts, the Redondo Beach Ward and the Hawthorne Ward, the voters will be voting for a member to represent them on the Board of Trustees. Running unopposed in the Second Ward is Al Wilson, poultryman, and in the Third Ward Robert Black, a telephone company employee.

Charles Ver Jones, Torrance's representative on the five-man board, has two more years to serve and is not running for reelection tomorrow.

The Board originally acquired the land, then a part of Alondra Park, through the efforts of Supervisor Raymond V. Darby. The county agreed to give the land to the college if it would construct facilities which could be used by the general public when not in use by the college. It was for this reason that the college erected recreational and physical education facilities ahead of certain permanent classroom structures which




