

Examination for Fire Department Officers Set

Promotional examinations for two Torrance Fire Department positions will be conducted by the Los Angeles County Civil Service Commission in City Council chambers Tuesday morning.

Fire Department personnel will be attempting to qualify for the newly created job of battalion chief and also for captains, four of which are to be appointed. Two chiefs will be named from the eligible lists.

Taking the chiefs examination will be fire captains Ivan Kettering, Gordon Northington, Gene Walker and Neal Whitney.

Hopefuls for the captains jobs are Leonard Chapman, Bill Johnson, Mill Langum, Bob Lucas, Bob Moffitt, D. J. Skidmore, Walt West and Harlan Whitacre.

The battalion chiefs will work on a platoon basis, one chief each twenty-four hours, assisting Fire Chief J. J. Benner. Captains who are appointed from the eligible list will be assigned to the Walteria and North Torrance stations, where presently a captain is on duty only every other day, and to fill any vacancy left by captains being appointed to the battalion chief jobs.

Salvation Army Summer Camping Plans Announced

Summer vacation plans for 3000 needy Southern California youngsters at two Salvation Army summer camps were announced this week by Lt. Col. Russell E. Clarke, Southern California Salvationist chief.

Upwards of 1000 needy children and their mothers will be entertained at the Army's Redondo Beach summer facility and 2000 boys and girls are expected to spend a week at the Mt. Crags camp in the Malibu Mountains.

Opening June 27 with a 10-day music institute at Mt. Crags, camping periods will start July 8, 14 and 21 for Salvation Army youth groups, and open registration periods will start July 29, Aug. 5, 12 and 19.

Applications from boys and girls between the ages of 8 and 16 are now being taken at 832 W. Ninth St., Los Angeles (Trinity 5571), for the open registration dates. Camp fees are \$15, including transportation and from camp from Los Angeles and insurance. Applicants unable to pay the full amount of the camp fees will be eligible for campships which are provided by interested friends.

Weekly periods from July 10 to Aug. 27 will be held for 1200 needy mothers and their young children at the Salvation Army's ocean resort at Redondo Beach, an agency of the Los Angeles Community Chest, Clarke said.
