Opening of Municipal Swimming Pools Brings Safety Warning

Within the next week or two, more than 100 swimming pools in most parts of Los Angeles County will offer free courses in swimming and life-saving to persons of all ages.

The courses will average about 10 lessons and will be repeated, from time to time during the summer months. Separate courses for beginning, intermediate and advanced swimmers will be given and instruction will meet the standards of the Water Safety Division of the American Red Cross. It is estimated that about 25,000 persons, most of them between the ages of 7 and 18, will receive ARC certificates for successful completion of tests which terminate each course.

Breakdown Given
Almost 90 per cent of the instruction will be devoted to teaching the various skills in the art of swimming. The remaining ten per cent, but a very important ten per cent, will be aimed at teaching the other fundamentals of water safety.

Life Saving Taught
Students in the more advanced courses are taught to master skills which can later be adapted to helping themselves and others should an emergency arise. They are also taught non-swimming methods of helping
