Local Dope Problem Told By Officials
Continued public educational programs are vital if enforcement agencies are to uncover and snuff out dope addiction among teen-aged youths.
This was the conclusion reached at a panel discussion held by the Torrance Moose Lodge Monday night attended by more than 60 persons.
Judge Otto B. Willett and Sgt. D. C. Cook, Torrance police juvenile officer, told the facts behind narcotics traffic in communities like Torrance. Judge Willett discussed the various laws which attempt to stop sale and use of drugs, and Cook explained the actual patterns of dope addiction.
George Powell was moderator. Members of the Moose Lodge and others who attended asked questions from the floor during a 30-minute session after the discussion.
Prior to the discussion, Moose members issued statements with regard to the dope problem.

Issue Statement
"We, the citizens of Torrance and of the United States, are alarmed. We have read with horror the stories in our newspapers concerning the increase towards addiction to narcotics and drugs. We thought, with our tongues in our cheeks, that it couldn't happen in Torrance. Then we learned that through the efficiency of our police department an agent working in Torrance with Torrance boys and girls was uncovered and apprehended.
"Pride and concern is not enough. There must be a program of education to protect the youth of the nation from the weaknesses of the adults," the statement concluded.

'BUNDLE WEEK' PLANNED FOR AREA SCHOOLS
Torrance Public Schools will take part in a state-wide Children's Clothing Crusade to collect serviceable used clothing during the week of Dec. 1-6. Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent of schools, stated yesterday. The project has the approval of the Board of Education.
Shown as Save the Children Bundle Week, the five-day clothing collection is part of a national campaign under the auspices of school superintendents.
Set Big Goal
A goal of 1,000,000 garments has been set by the school administrators for the state.
Clothing obtained will be distributed to handicapped rural areas of the United States, on Indian reservations, in Western Europe, the Far and Near East. Child war victims in Korea, Finland, France, Greece, Austria, Germany, Italy and Lebanon will be overseas beneficiaries. In America, clothing is distributed in a carefully-planned self-help program in rural areas of eight southern states.
