### '53 Plymouths Now On Display; Contest Open

Plymouth Motor Corp. today presents its 1953 lines in Torrance showrooms coincident with the opening of a nation-wide contest in which six automobiles and 300 cash prizes will be awarded.

The 1953 Plymouth models will be on display at Whittlesey Motors, 1600 Cabrillo Ave., and Dick Barton's, 1835 Torrance Blvd. Contest entry blanks can be secured from both Torrance Plymouth dealers.

Anyone 18 or older may enter the contest, except Plymouth dealers or their families, or families of advertising agents for the auto company. The first prize is a 1953 Plymouth Cranbrook convertible club coupe with the next five prizes Cranbrook sedans. Ten prizes of \$500, 25 of \$200, 50 of \$25 and 275 of \$10 will also be awarded.

**Opens Today**

The contest opens today and closes Monday, Nov. 24. Winners will be announced about five weeks after the close of the contest. To be eligible, the entry must appear on the official blank, available only at Plymouth dealers.

Subject of the contest is "What I like most about the new 1953 Plymouth," the statement to be completed in 50 words or less.

"This year," said George Whittlesey, Plymouth is introducing a new concept of automobile design in the low priced field. Super-styling is coordinated with radical engineering developments to produce the truly balanced car for easier, safer and more comfortable driving.

According to Barton, "this car is a tribute to the engineers. They have succeeded in controlling to an unprecedented degree the three movements which have plagued designers since the first automobile was built—roll, pitch and bounce."

In the Cambridge line, the company offers a four-door sedan, a two-door sedan, a business coupe and the Suburban.

An innovation on all two-door models is the front seat, which is divided at one-third of its width to permit easier entrance and exit for rear seat passengers from the curb side. Two can sit comfortably on the wider portion of the front seat while the remainder is tilted forward for easy back seat access.

"Control tower" visibility is provided with a one-piece curved windshield and a new, larger one-piece rear window. Interior styling is new. Box type seat trim gives both front and rear seats a smart appearance, and upholstery, interior molding and trim are available in a wide variety of hues.

### West Basin Water Group Directors To Meet Today

With discussion of pending litigation on water rights in the area high on the agenda, the West Basin Water Association directors will meet today at 6:30 p.m. at the Palos Verdes Country Club.

President Ben Haggott will report on legislation that may be sponsored by Orange County and Central Basin representatives to supply means of paying for water used in replenishment and Paul Baumann, assistant chief engineer of the Los Angeles County Flood Control District will reveal the status of the salt water barrier test and the possibility of obtaining effluent from Hyperion to be used in extending the test.

In other matters, the board revealed it has accepted the resignation of R. T. Hutchins, effective Nov. 3. William R. Selby of El Segundo was appointed to serve for the balance of the unexpired term.
