

Ladies Night Slated By Management Club

It will be Ladies' Night next Wednesday when the National Supply Management Club holds a 7 p.m. dinner meeting at Scully's Restaurant in Los Angeles.

Program will feature an address by Kurt D. Singer, world-renowned lecturer and writer, who has just returned from Europe and the Middle East, and whose espionage reports entitled "Spies and Traitors" have been utilized by the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission.

"Assassination is employed to day by the Communists just as it once was by the Medici and the Borgias," according to Singer. He is author of 18 volumes published in 21 languages.

His most recent book, "The World's Greatest Women Spies," has been sold to a major motion picture studio.

From 1934 to 1936, Singer published one of the earliest German underground newspapers. When his book, "Goering," appeared, the Nazis put a price on his head and he was indicted for high treason. His wife was held as a hostage for more than a year, and the Swedish government confiscated all copies of his book while he continued to work inside the Scandinavian underground.

During this period he also founded the Ossietzky Committee which fought for and brought Ossietzky's release from a concentration camp and the award of the Nobel Peace Prize in 1937.
