Riviera Run Will Take 24 Minutes

A new Torrance Municipal Bus route put in operation last Monday gives residents of two new housing tracts, Sepulveda Gardens and Allied Gardens, transportation to Hollywood Riviera and Torrance.

The new route, going from Carson St. to Hollywood Riviera by way of the Gardens in 24 minutes, is as follows:

1. Carson St. to Madrona Ave., down Sepulveda Blvd. to Ellinwood Dr., over Milne Dr. to Palos Verdes Blvd., down Susanne Ave. to Sunnyview St., over Linda Dr. to Reese Rd., down Doris Way, over to 101 Hwy. and on into Hollywood Riviera.

over to 104 Hwy. and on into Hollywood Riviera.

Buses will return over the same route, making eight trips a day, according to Marshall F. Chamberlain, bus superintendent.

Oil Well Pump House Destroyed By Fire Tuesday

Fire destroyed an oil well pump house at 2062 W. 231st St. early Tuesday morning, the Torrance Fire Department reported.

The pump house was located on Sargent No. 1 lease, owned and operated by Argent Bros. Cause was believed to be a slipping belt on the pump engine, causing friction which set off sparks to ignite the structure.

Engines 1 and 2, responding to the call, were misdirected to a wrong address, and by the time they reached the scene, the building was completely involved. Capt. R. R. Lunas directed the company. The fact that the derrick had been removed from the producing well kept the flames confined to the single pump house, rather than involving other structures in the field.

The call came in at 2:31 a.m. and firemen did not return to the central fire station until 4:35 a.m.

Civil Defense Leaders Discuss Disaster Teams

George Powell, assistant director of Civil Defense for Torrance, and J. Hugh Sherfy Jr., partner in Stone and Myers Mortuary, attended a meeting of the Coroner's Service of Area G. last evening where Sherfy presented a discussion on the formation of such a service team under the city's Civil Defense program.

The Torrance team, under the direction of Capt. Ernest Ashton of the Torrance Police Department, is one of several such teams that have been organized throughout California to operate in the event of a major disaster or enemy attack.

A major problem in any disaster area is identification of the dead, Powell said yesterday, and a coroner's service team would be in charge of this responsibility in the event of a major catastrophe.
