March of Dimes For 1953 Set Jan. 2 to 31

The 1953 March of Dimes campaign will run from Jan. 2 through 31 in Los Angeles area and across the nation, Mrs. Clara A. Conner, Torrance chairman, announced yesterday.

An all-time high of polio cases makes necessary a month-long campaign for the second time in history, according to Stuart Chevalier, chairman of the executive committee of the Los Angeles County chapter of the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis.

At the same time, added funds are needed to push research to success in finding a polio preventive, he said.

"We are so close to defeating polio, and yet so far as the disease takes a constantly greater toll," Chevalier declared. "The coming campaign will be crucial in human history."

Volunteer workers to help with the drive are desperately needed at this time, he said. Any willing hands can be used, particularly with typing, filing, and stuffing.
