

'Better Fishing' Guide Available

"Better Fishing in California," an illustrated pamphlet explaining the inland water fisheries management policies of the Fish and Game Commission, is available without charge at five headquarters offices of the Department of Fish and Game.

The new official publication sums up the objectives of the Department "to supply the best possible fishing for the greatest number of anglers with only the minimum of restrictions and regulations necessary to insure a continued supply, fair distribution, and proper utilization." The policy was adopted last

year "for the guidance of the staff and others concerned in the development of maximum fresh-water fishing opportunities for a rapidly growing army of anglers."

It places emphasis on the need in California for improve-

ment of fish habitat and fish ing waters, while minimizing the role of the fish hatchery. Artificial propagation of trout is "not a universal answer to all fishery problems, and will be subject to constant checks to determine the value of results obtained," the policy asserts.
