**New Registration System Planned for El Camino**

"Preferential registration," a system designed to give incentive to students to receive the maximum benefit from the counseling program, will be a part of enrollment procedure at El Camino College in the fall semester, Merl F. Sloan, director of student personnel, said yesterday.




