



### Former Trojan Grid Star Named Football Coach at Santa Monica

Former Trojan grid star Bob Stillwell Tuesday was named head football coach at Santa Monica High to succeed Jim "Suds" Sutherland, who resigned to take a backfield coaching berth at the University of California.

Stillwell, 26, handled the line duties for Sutherland last season and helped guide Samoa to the CIF championship.

The new Viking mentor went to Santa Monica from Inglewood, where he assisted Marty Ernaga when Inglewood produced the highest scoring team in the CIF two seasons ago.

As Sutherland's successor, Stillwell takes over one of the CIF's roughest prep grid assignments, Suds won or tied for the Bay League title in eight out of nine years at Samoa and knocked down three CIF crowns.

No other changes in the Samoa coaching staff were announced.


