Ceremonies Held Dedicating Salt Water Barrier

Formal ceremonies officially dedicated the Manhattan Beach barrier test, a project to prevent the intrusion of sea water into fresh water well, recently.

Presiding at the rites were C. A. Griffith, chairman of the State Water Resources Board; H. E. Hedger, chief engineer of Los Angeles County Flood Control District; and Ben Haggott, president of West Basin Water Association and director of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.

A field laboratory has been set up on the test site to facilitate measuring and sampling of the five injection wells and 30-

more observation wells, association officials said. Included in the equipment is a central chlorinating plant, which accomplishes all chlorinating in one operation. Previously the chlorination was performed at each individual well.

The test will operate on a 24-hour basis until conclusive results are obtained sometime next fall, the West Basin leaders said. Levy of a five-cent tax for Zone 1 in the Central Basin area was vetoed unanimously Tuesday by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors. Zone 1 has been organized for two years but has never been in active operation. A poll of communities in

the area, recently conducted by Supervisor Herberg C. Legg, revealed that opinion is divided as to desirability of activating the Zone.

A proposal that Zone 2 be formed in the West Basin is now being studied by the Los Angeles County Flood Control District at the request of the Board of Supervisors, the West Basin Water Association, and the West Basin Municipal Water District. A petition for annexation of the City of Hawthorne is expected to be submitted to the Board of Directors at its meeting when they meet tomorrow, 3 p.m., in the District office, Hermosa Beach.
