Overeating Called Worst US Disorder

devastating nutritional disorder in the United States today. Studies conducted at the University of Minnesota indicate that the amount of food intake should be reduced after a person reaches 25 years of age. The correct reduction was computed to be about 7 1/2 per cent for each ten-year period after age 25. By the age of 70 years a person should eat only 70 per cent of what he ate at 25. These figures are based on the fact that the studies showed that with advancing years the lean tissues of the body tend to deteriorate probably because of lessened physical activity, but the percentage of fatty material increases. Another study conducted at the University of Iowa indicated that if the food intake is decreased as a person grows older, the reduction should best be made at the mid-day or evening meals. The Iowa experiment was conducted on a group of men ranging in age from sixty to eighty-three years. It was found that leaving out breakfast resulted in an increased tremor and a decrease in strength and endurance. Further studies conducted on both young and old age groups indicated that a good breakfast should contain protein in order to keep blood-sugar at a level necessary to prevent fatigue. The more adequate breakfast was in protein content, the longer the blood-sugar level was sustained. Poor dietary habits, especially those causing overweight, are responsible for a great many disabilities and chronic conditions in later life.
