

# Funeral Services Held for Pioneer Torrance Lawyer

Final respects were paid yesterday to Charles Mitschrich, well-known local attorney, whose funeral services were held at Patterson and Sively Mortuary in Long Beach.

Mitschrich practiced law in Torrance for 32 years, having come here in 1921 from Lawton, Oklahoma. His local office was at 1835 W. 213th St.

Mrs. Mable Steinhilber of the First Baptist Church of Christ, Scientist read the service. Following the rites, a private interment was held.

Mitschrich, a native of Berlin, Germany, is survived by three sons, Albert H., of Houston, Tex.; M. F. Mitschrich, of St. Louis, Mo., and H. C. Mitschrich, of Oklahoma City; two daughters, Mrs. Alta Wright, of Houston, Tex., and Mrs. Florence Ott of Ponca City, Okla.; and four grandchildren.

The popular attorney died on May 15 in Seaside Memorial Hospital at the age of 85.


