Figures Show Slow Increase In Unemployed

A steady rise in number of unemployed in Torrance was shown this week by figures released in January, compared to 648 in November, according to a report from the California Department of Employment.

A total of 732 residents of Torrance are unemployed and seeking work through the office in January, compared to 648 in December and 648 in November, according to Winona Ellis, manager of the office.

Of the 732 persons, 272 are women and 460 are men, 38 per cent of the men are veterans, a few of whom are disabled. Included on the list are 18 unemployed professional people, including accountants, civil engineers, nurses, draftsmen, buyers and purchasing agents; 81 clerical workers; 22 salespeople; 84 service workers; 34 agricultural and fishing workers; 332 skilled workers; 106 semi-skilled workers; and 196 laborers.
