Local Adventist Group To Attend Graduation Rites

A group of 75 youngsters from the Torrance Seventh Day Adventist Church, accompanied by Elise Thorson, will attend a mass Bible School graduation exercise for 200 students to be held at the Shrine Auditorium Saturday at 2:45 p.m.

H. M. S. Richards, director of the "Voice of Prophecy" radio program and Bible school, will deliver the commencement address and present the diplomas to the graduates. The Saturday Bible School graduates were recruited as students by the efforts of 4000 Adventist youths in Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and Ventura counties in back-to-the-Bible crusades held a year ago.

Richards recently came back from a world tour and is making his first public appearance since his return. Under the heading of his commencement address, "Living Miracles," Richards will tell of other graduates of the Bible course, now given in 52 languages, whom he met on his tour.

A combined youth academy choir of 200 voices, under the direction of Miller Brackett, executive youth secretary of the Southern California Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists, and a male chorus of 60 ministers will sing.

"This is the Way to a Life of Prayer" will be the subject of the 11 a.m. sermon at the First Baptist Church of Waiwala, Park and Newton Sts., to be delivered by the Rev. Andrew Duty, pastor.

The Rev. Duty also will report on the meeting of the Regular Baptist Pastors Fellowship being held this week in Asilomar, Calif.

At the 7:30 evening service, the message will be titled "Life Out of Death" from the book of Colossians.


Arrangements have been completed to house the young people at Fuller's Lodge at Big Bear on Friday.


